

## **David Laird Campground**

is a fully serviced, beautifully treed modern campground located on the south east side of North Battleford, SK. between highway 40 and highway 16 just behind the Western Development Museum. There are 17 fully serviced sites, 21 electric / water sites and 22 non serviced sites available.

David Laird Campground offers many pull through sites – both serviced and nonserviced that can accommodate large RV's. The campground is open from the beginning of May to the end of September.

There is an office with concession, two shower houses in different parts of the campground for your convenience, firewood, free wifi, sanidump and potable water filling station, playground, gazebo and picnic/large outdoor BBQ area. There is also a year round stocked trout pond (provincial fishing license required) directly beside the campground.





David Laird Campground is located near the Western Development Museum and less than 2 km from North Battleford's shopping areas. It is an ideal spot to camp at and still be within reach of city services.

Campground management is provided by Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) Battlefords Branch's TEP 2 (work experience) program. CMHA is a non profit organization that provides programs, support and service to persons living with mental illness, works to reduce stigma and promotes 'mental health for all' through advocacy, education and awareness.



David Laird Campground is named after the Lieutenant Governor of the Northwest Territories from 1876 to 1883. During his term, David Laird ordered the capital of the Northwest Territories moved from Fort Livingstone to Battleford.

Laird, Saskatchewan is also named after David Laird.
