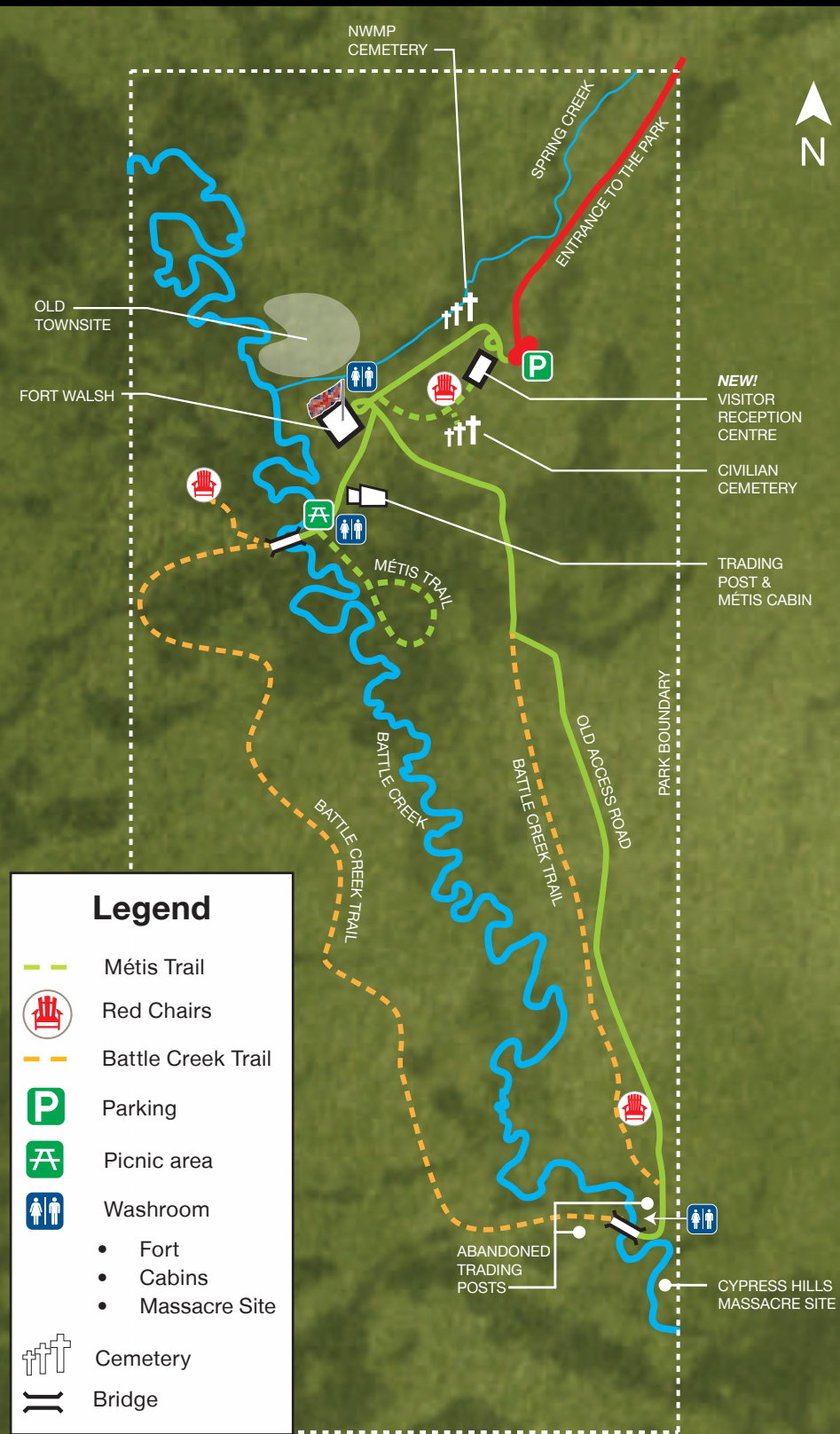
### Frontier Life
