As the 19th century closed, a stream of pioneer-farmers moved west from Ontario, seeking a new life on the prairies. Early Saskatchewan settler, W.R. Motherwell became a community leader whose passion for scientific farming methods took him all the way to parliament as Minister of Agriculture. Come home to discover the life of a prairie farmer in the 1900s on W.R. Motherwell's historic homestead, Lanark Place.
