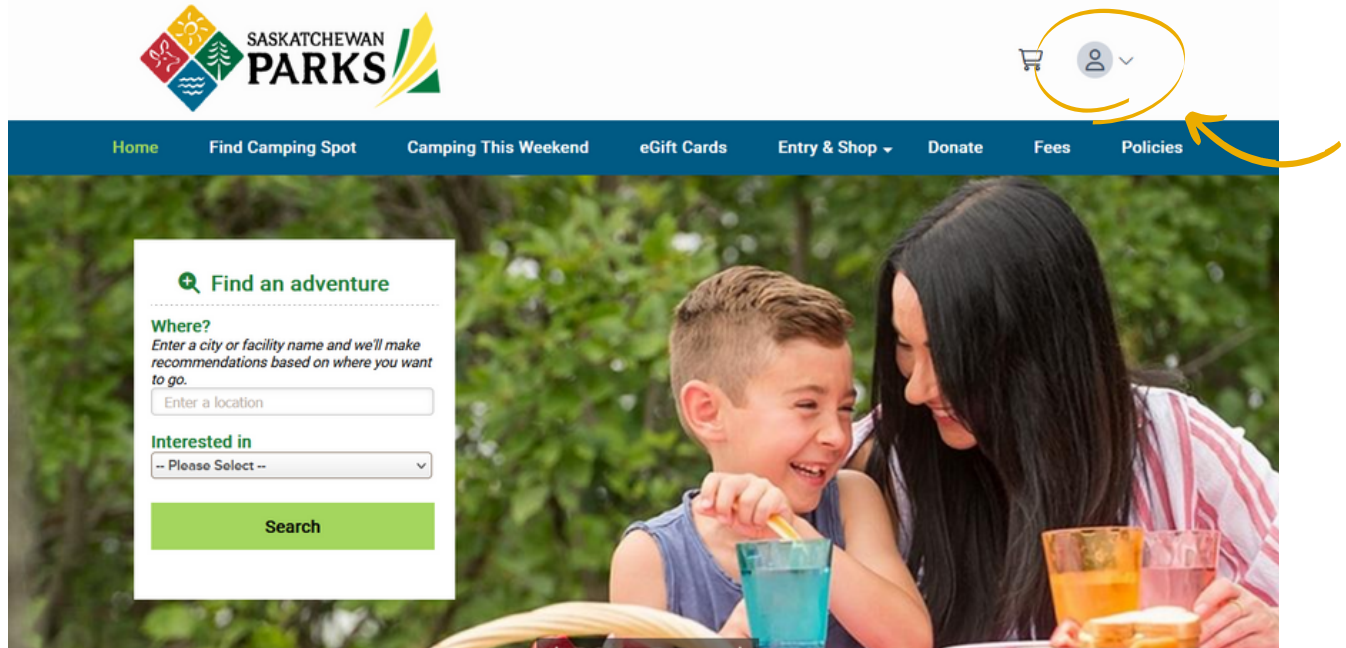


BOOK A SEASONAL CAMPSITE

Step 1

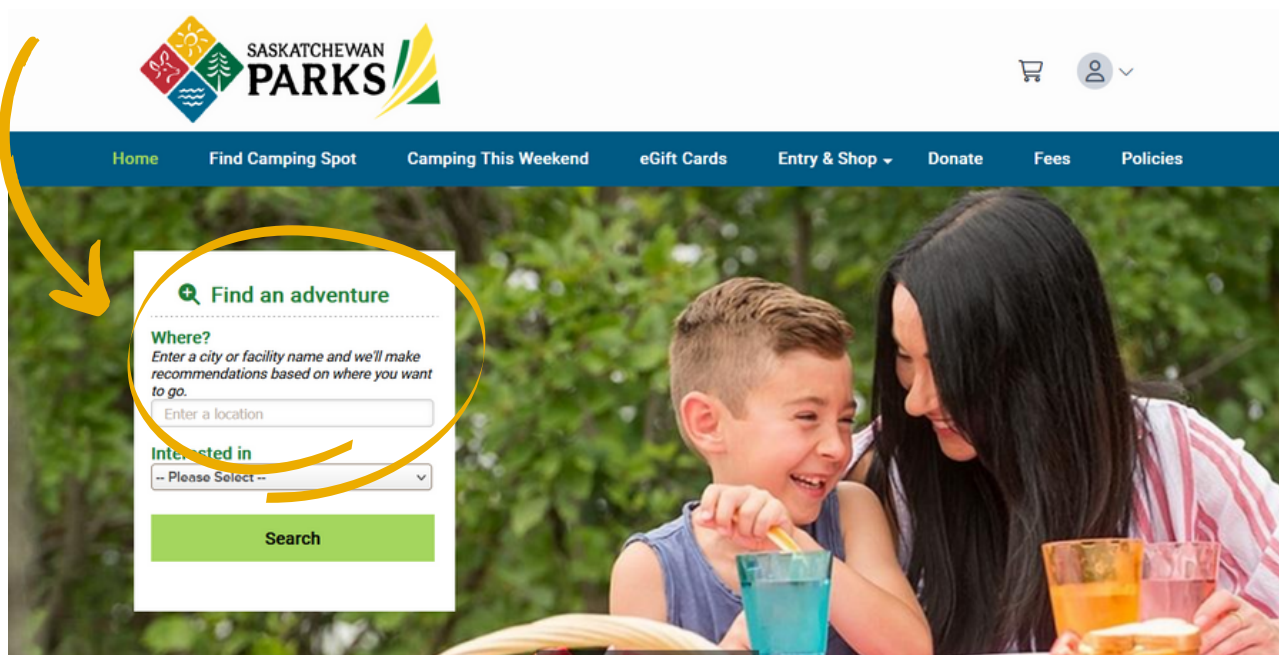
Go to parks.saskatchewan.ca, hover over the profile icon in the top right corner, and click "Sign In / Sign Up"



Step 2: It's time to find an adventure!

Enter a park name and click "Search".

- You can also leave the location blank to show all parks.



Step 3: What are you looking for and interested in?

- Select "Camping & Swimming" from the "Interested In" dropdown.
- Select "Seasonal Camping" from the "Looking for" dropdown.
- Enter the length of your camping unit if you like. Leave the other fields blank to see all parks offering seasonal camping.
- Hit "Search."

Step 7: Confirm your order details

- Equipment
 - Enter your Primary Equipment from the drop down menu.
- Enter your Primary Equipment length (take note of the Max Length below the box).
- Site Occupants
 - Enter the number of occupants you are booking for (cannot exceed 6 people).
 - Enter the number of vehicles you require to purchase an Annual Park Entry Permit for (Min 1, Max 2)
 - Choose the Primary Occupant. This may be yourself or another person. When choosing "Other" occupant you will be required to enter their full details including first name, last name, complete mailing address, phone number and email address.
- Alerts and Important Information
 - Read the Alerts and Important Information. When completed, click "Yes, I have read and understood this important information" to agree to the terms.
 - Click "Continue to Shopping Cart" to proceed to check out.

Alerts and Important Information

Park

Those reserving campsites or facilities in Sask Parks must follow all Saskatchewan public health orders and guidelines and should stay up to date on Saskatchewan.ca. Reservations or events may be subject to change.

- Permit holders are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their family and guests and must ensure all Saskatchewan Provincial Parks rules and regulations are being met.
- A valid vehicle entry permit is required on all vehicles while in a provincial park. All visitors must possess and display a valid Park Entry Permit.
- Pets are welcome in all Saskatchewan Provincial Parks and must be on a leash no longer than two meters. Owners are responsible for the behavior of their pets at all times and must clean up after their pets. Pets are not allowed in buildings, public places or on the beach.
- Campfires are only permitted in park supplied fire pits and barbecues. Firewood is provided at no cost. Firewood from outside the park is not permitted.
- Wildlife is present in the park and feeding wildlife is prohibited. Keep campsite clean and all food, garbage, and attractants securely stored. Bird feeders are not permitted in campgrounds
- Fees and charges are subject to change at any time. If site fees change, we will honor the fees in effect when you made the reservation, as long as you do not change the reservation. If you make changes, we will apply the new fees.

Step 8: Buy Add-ons (Optional)

Here you can choose to purchase an Annual Park Entry Permit.

- If you purchase an annual vehicle entry permit online, the permit will be mailed to the mailing address associated with your reservation or the address specified when purchasing online. Allow at least 8-10 business days from the date of purchase for delivery. A temporary pass that is valid for 3 weeks from the date of purchase will be emailed to you to use until your permit arrives.
- Saskatchewan residents 65 years or older (or turn 65 in the current year) may receive free daily, weekly or an annual entry to Saskatchewan Provincial Parks upon proof of age with government-issued ID at the park. A senior annual vehicle entry permit is assigned to your Sask Parks customer account and are for your use only in Saskatchewan Provincial Parks. Senior Entry Permits are available in-park only.

Shop add-ons for your site

Vehicle entry (Vehicle Entry Permit) is required year round and is charged on a per vehicle basis and must be paid for and displayed in order to access any Saskatchewan Provincial Park. A valid Vehicle Entry Permit purchased at one Saskatchewan Provincial Park is a valid at all Saskatchewan Provincial Parks.

- Annual Vehicle Entry Permit: Valid in any Saskatchewan Provincial Park from Apr 30 until Apr 30 of each year. Recommended for stays over 7 days.
- Senior Vehicle Entry Permit: Saskatchewan Seniors over 65 permits FREE with valid Saskatchewan ID. Available at park entry gate.

Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Policies and Rules

- A \$12 reservation fee covers the cost of administering the reservation service. An additional \$2 surcharge will apply to all transactions using the call centre.
- You may change or cancel your reservation by visiting parks.saskatchewan.ca or by calling the Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Reservation Call Centre at 1-833-775-7275.
- Reservation, change and cancellation fees are non-refundable.
- Where a refundable damage deposit is required, this must be paid in full at the time of reservation. If no damage occurs during your stay, you will be refunded the damage deposit.
- Change and cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved and outlined under Fees and Policies on parks.saskatchewan.ca. If a change or cancellation is not covered by these penalties, Saskatchewan Provincial Parks will apply the relevant transaction/penalty charges if you:
 - Shorten any dates on a reservation.
 - Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.
 - Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity.
