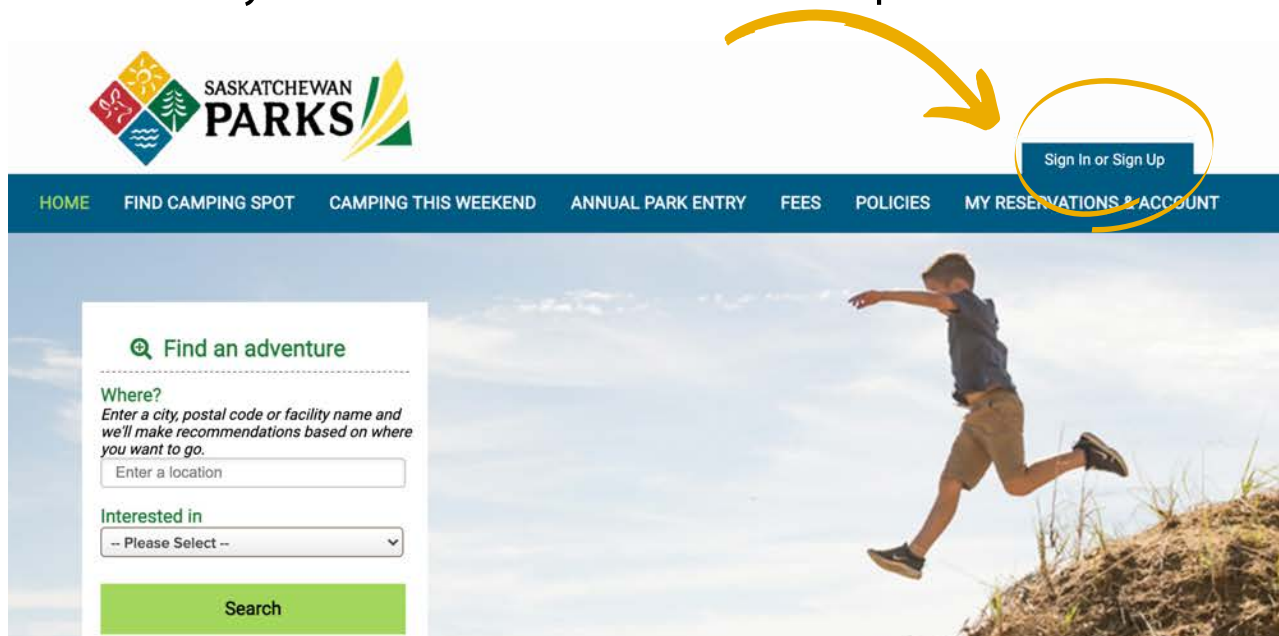


HOW TO CHANGE YOUR PASSWORD

A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

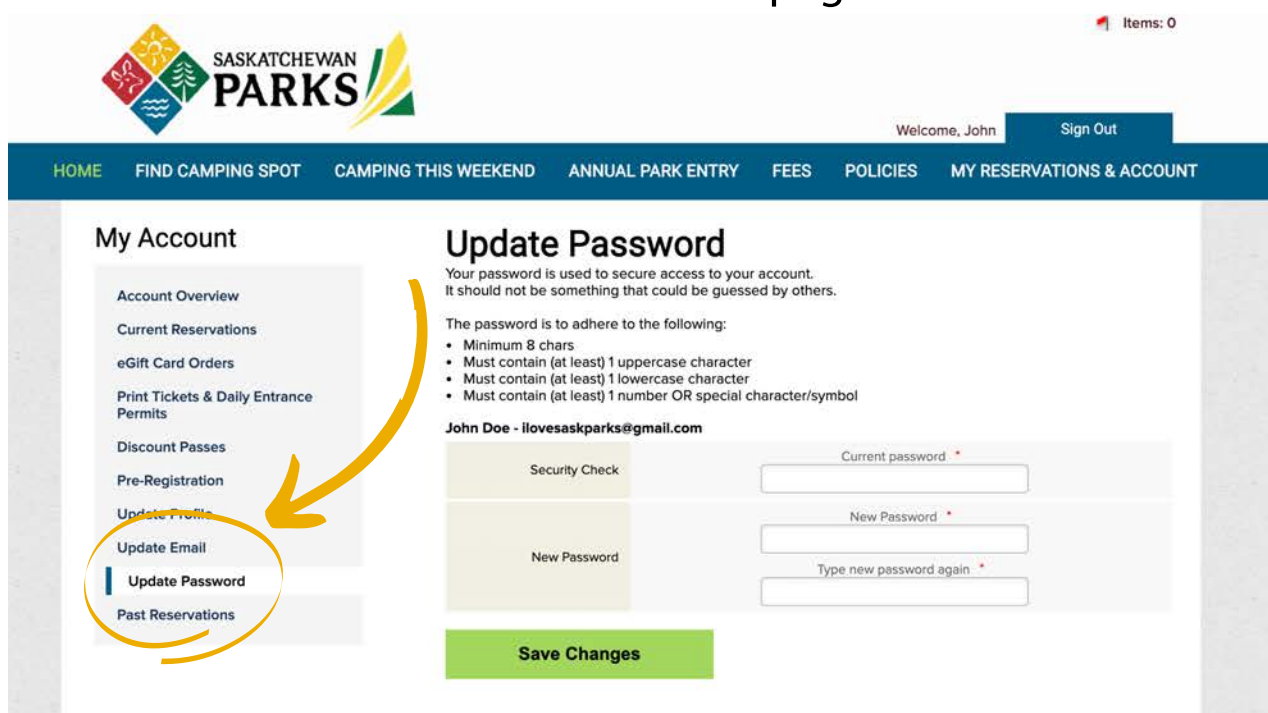
Step 1

Log in to your account using the "Sign In" tab in the top right corner. Use your email address and current password.



Step 2

Once logged in, the following page will display. Select "Update Password" on the left-hand side of the page.



Step 3

Enter your current password and then your new password twice. Select "Save Changes"
